1. WHAT TO DO NOW

There are things you, as a member of NEIUPI, can and should do RIGHT NOW:

a) PLEASE show up-in a green shirt-at the Board of Trustees Meeting at 1 PM on THURSDAY, September 22, in Alumni Hall. We need our presence to be felt. Public comments of 3 minutes each are welcome at BOT meetings, so please feel free to comment if you feel moved to do so! The BOT does not have a realistic picture of what is actually going on at NEIU-the enrollment crisis, the lack of clear and competent leadership, the lagging pace of contract negotiations, etc. We can make sure that they hear about all of this by speaking at their meeting and/or showing up to support those who do. To make a public comment, submit a written request by 4 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 21, 2022 to Karl Voigt at public-comment@neiu.edu. The request must include the name and contact information of the person

- wishing to speak, the name of the group represented, and the topic you wish to speak about.
- b) READ the NEIU Administration's April 2022 Budget Town Hall responses on NEIUport. That's right, the administration is finally responding 5 months after the questions were asked. You can find the responses on the NEIU Central tab, in the Budget Town Hall channel, under April 2022, in a link titled 'April 27 Questions.' Why do this? Because it's clear that the NEIU Administration is going to use the budget / enrollment issue to push back on our demands.

Got student debt? Know someone who does?

Get INFORMED, for yourself and for others:

The University Professionals of Illinois is proud to <u>host 2 virtual Student Debt Clinics for members and friends</u>. <u>Register at the links below</u>.

Student loan payments will restart in January. The deadline for applying for loan forgiveness under the new and more flexible rules is October 31. If you haven't explored the possibility of loan forgiveness because you aren't sure, don't believe you qualify, or were denied prior to the new rules, I urge you to register for our Student Debt Clinic to ensure you don't miss the opportunity to apply. Working at NEIU qualifies you for existing public service loan forgiveness programs along with the new debt forgiveness.

To help our members get access to these programs and understand these new rules, UPI and the American Federation of Teachers will host a Student Debt Clinic which will provide information on how to enroll in Income-Driven Repayment plans and Public Service Loan Forgiveness.
