Little Progress / Big Chaos

Just before winter break, the NEIU Board of Trustees canceled an emergency meeting at which many faculty were scheduled for public comment. The lame-duck / interim administration is attempting to push through a radical reorganization of the colleges to prepare for their claim that enrollment will decline another 10% next year. That is likely if the people in charge of recruitment and retention are not doing their jobs. The scandal of the month is the confirmation that the Associate VP for Student Success and Retention has been doing the job almost entirely remotely, while simultaneously holding a full-time, tenure track faculty position at Wayne State University in Detroit.

Meanwhile, we continue bargaining for a fair contract. At the negotiation session on Thursday 1/12/23, UPI and NEIU TA'ed Article 5 on personnel files (a "TA" means "tentative agreement"), the first item agreed to after 6 months of bargaining.

Bargaining sessions have moved to Thursdays 1:00 - 2:30 pm. You are invited to attend and observe!

What are you willing to do to get a fair contract?
