## Faculty Discontent Roils NEIU; Contract Negotiations Continue with limited movement

Faculty discontent and public resistance toward the NEIU Administration's poor leadership has come to a head in recent weeks. The Faculty Assembly's votes of no confidence in the President and Board of Trustees (BOT), engagement with our political representatives, and vocal protests during President Gibson's recent "Town Hall" demonstrate how fed up our colleagues are with the mismanagement of NEIU that is putting our livelihoods in danger. While NEIUPI can't lead these protests while we are in negotiations with the administration, we recognize our members and other people in our NEIU community who are raising their voices to save the soul of this university. Disruption is a time-honored and valuable form of protest from those who are not being heard; dissent is democratic and we in the union believe it is both valid and valuable. At the same time, UPI's role in the ongoing challenges with campus leadership is that we continue to focus on negotiating the contract that will define our working conditions for years to come, and more importantly define the respect that we seek as faculty and staff at this University. As we all fight in so many different

ways for a better future for NEIU, <u>we cannot forget that a fair contract is a key part of cementing that future. The Administration is spooked and there has been progress in negotiations. Help us keep up the pressure!</u>
