## **NEIUPI Bargaining Update**

## April 20, 2023

- The pressure from our strike authorization vote and rally at the BoT last week has led to <u>significant</u> <u>progress in negotiations!</u>
- Over the last 8 months, we reached 6 Tentative Agreements (TAs) on proposed articles for the contract. We have reached <u>5 TAs this week alone</u>, with another 2 very close
- The Admin has also <u>moved significantly on their financial proposal</u>
- The new Board of Trustees is clearly motivated to negotiate a fair contract with us, but we must still prepare for the possibility of a strike and keep up the pressure!
